**The Intrinsic Spagyric Botanicals** are handmade remedies manufactured in accordance with the proven laws and time-honoured processes of Spagyrisms, laid down hundreds of years ago. It takes 60-90 days to make the concentrated tincture which has been decanted into a 60mL cobalt blue bottle (protects the remedy). Labelling and bottling are performed without electricity. All raw materials are bio-dynamically grown or wildcrafted, and draw from the finest ancient and modern traditions of herbal medicine from the West, Ayurvedic India, South American Amazon, and Traditional Chinese Botanicals. The name of the (ethno) Intrinsic formulas represents the keynote focal remedy ingredients to which the other ingredients constellate, differentiate and amplify.

**The ileo-cecal valve (ICV), located between the ileum of the small intestine and the cecum of the large intestine, has two primary functions:**

1. To control the flow between these two areas and provide a barrier preventing the bacteria-laden contents of the large bowel from contaminating the small intestine.
2. To keep the contents in the small intestine long enough for all digestive processes to be completed.

**Spasm of the ileo-cecal valve can sometimes occur**, causing it to become locked in either a "closed" or "open" position. A "closed" position blocks the flow of material from the small intestine to the large intestine, preventing proper elimination of waste materials from the body. An "open" position, caused by an ICV that has become flaccid and weak, allows xenobiotic-laden fecal material to backwash into the small intestine, ultimately leading to toxicity (autointoxication).

**The ICV, cecum, and appendix are primary breeding grounds** for parasites, bacteria, Candida and yeasts. Any blockage in the normal flow between these areas of the digestive tract can result in microbial infestation, dysbiosis and a host of other problems.

**Alternating diarrhea and constipation**, sometimes with accompanying dark circles under the eyes, are a good indication of problems with the ileo-cecal valve.

**ICV syndromes can be called "Great Mimickers"**, as they can be at the root of many non-specific conditions, including headaches, pain in the right shoulder, constipation, diarrhea, back pain, disc problems, and a host of other conditions. Unfortunately, ICV syndromes are often overlooked in many healing arts' strategies and diagnostics.

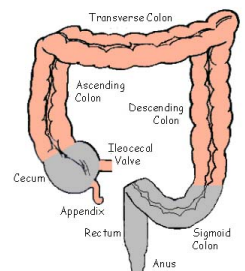
**Black Radish Intrinsic is a synergistic combination of Spagyric botanicals designed to support healthy digestion and the health of the liver-biliary tree.**

**Black Radish Intrinsic activates the liver cells** by increasing the effect of regeneration, decongestion and protection. Its cleansing and antibacterial flavonoid compounds maintain a healthy gallbladder and act as an excellent co-adjuvant for hepatic colic by stimulating the secretion of bile and increasing peristaltic action.

**An increase in peristaltic action stimulates** the transition of fecal matter through the anus, helping to eliminate excessive blood pooling in the abdomen, lowering blood pressure and the congestion of the internal and/or external venous plexuses around the anal canal — a major cause of hemorrhoids and varicosities.

**Food entering the digestive system can be a painful process** for some people due to a permanent shortening of the esophagus (perhaps caused by inflammation and scarring from the reflux or regurgitation of stomach acid). The naturally occurring alkaloids in **Black Radish Intrinsic** address this factor while concurrently providing anti-inflammatory and binding elements to help seal the area.

**Black Radish Intrinsic should be considered in all conditions involving the health of the digestive system, and especially in the case of suspected ICV dysfunction or hiatal hernia.**
